PSALM 92 (93)

Thy throne is prepared from of old: * thou art from everlasting. The floods have lifted up, O Lord: * the floods have lifted up their voice.

The floods have lifted up their waves, * with the noise of many waters. Wonderful are the surges of the sea: * wonderful is the Lord on high.
